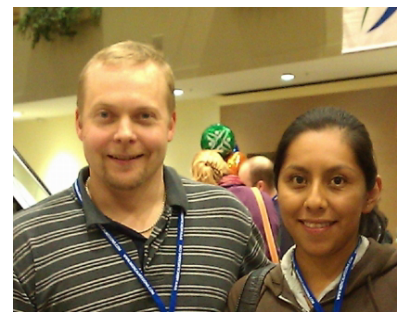
50 of us Listened to Jason & Heather Fader over Lunch

There were 2500 at the conference, attending 105 seminars, 4 plenary sessions, and 168 Medical Missions Agencies on 2 floors of the exhibit hall. 30 years ago, for every 100 students who started Med School intent on missions, one would make it to the field.

We want to encourage our students to follow Christ for the long haul, and give them the connections to help them succeed.
